- ESTABLISHED IN 2014 IN PERE A REMOTE VILLAGE 210 KM FAR FROM THE CAPITOL (26-32% OF THE STUDENTS ARE DISADVANTAGED)
- 2 SOCIOLOGY STUDENTS STARTED THE PROJECT
- THE IDEA WAS AN AFTERSCHOOL RUN ON WEEKENDS WITH THE HELP AND

MENTORING OF VOLUNTEERS





- SINCE 2014 THEY INVOLVED MORE THAN 100 KIDS FROM 4 VILLAGES
- AROUND 300 VOLUNTEERS TOOK PART IN THE PROGRAMME DIFFERENT BACKGROUNDS, EXPERTISE THEY DEVELOPED DIFFERENT SKILLS OF THE KIDS
- REQUIRED STRONG LOGISTICS HOURS COMPLETED VOLUNTEERING/MONTH,
 TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS (MOSTLY FROM BUDAPEST)
