CHALLENGES/PROBLEMS

- Housing conditions
- Locked architecture
- Lack of public and private services (education, healthcare, shops, etc)
- General homogeneity: low level of education, low economic power, ethnicity, general poverty with „self-invented” class system, high level of unemployment
- high rate of petty crimes



COMPLEX PROBLEMS CALL FOR COMPLEX SOLUTION

Dozens of ESF funded complex de-segregation programmes were run across the country, including Gyöngyös, implemented by the local council in partnership with the Hungarian Charity Service of the Order of Malta.



THE METHOD OF DEVELOPMENT

The council develops a Community Development Plan and a Housing Intervention Plan in preparatory phase of the project.

The plans should include a very detailed, step-by-step intervention plan tailored to the community.

The formulation of the plans should be a series of planning meetings with the community of the segregate and the population living outside of the segregate.



AREAS OF INTERVENTION - GYÖNGYÖS

- Social intervention: social work (on the spot), family care, community work → empowerment process
- Education intervention: vocational training, 60 people (gardener, mason, painter, etc)
- Community intervention: forums, voluntary actions, family days
- Employment: labour-market counselling, subsidized employment
- Complementary actions for the children as main target group
