- ESTABLISHED IN 2014 IN PERE – A REMOTE VILLAGE 210 KM FAR FROM THE CAPITOL (26-32% OF THE STUDENTS ARE DISADVANTAGED)
- 2 SOCIOLOGY STUDENTS STARTED THE PROJECT
- THE IDEA WAS AN AFTERSCHOOL RUN ON WEEKENDS WITH THE HELP AND MENTORING OF VOLUNTEERS





- SINCE 2014 THEY INVOLVED MORE THAN 100 KIDS FROM 4 VILLAGES
- AROUND 300 VOLUNTEERS TOOK PART IN THE PROGRAMME – DIFFERENT BACKGROUNDS, EXPERTISE – THEY DEVELOPED DIFFERENT SKILLS OF THE KIDS
- REQUIRED STRONG LOGISTICS – HOURS COMPLETED VOLUNTEERING/MONTH, TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS (MOSTLY FROM BUDAPEST)



- COMPETENCE DEVELOPMENT
- EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMME
- THEMATIC CAMPS (MEDIA CAMP, ART CAMP, MAGIC CAMP, ETC.)
- MENTORING PROCESS
- SOCIAL CO-OPERATIVE OPERATING A GUEST HOUSE TO PRODUCE MORE BUDGET FOR THE COSTS – STRENGTHENING THE VILLAGE COMMUNITIES
