GENERAL OBJECTIVE:

Increasing the level of education and training of human resources through a lifecycle approach in the context of the sustainable development of the knowledge-based society.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

1.Creating a functional framework capable of increasing the level of education and training of human resources;

2.Develop inclusive education policies that favor the access of vulnerable groups to education both at the county level (the development strategy of the two counties) and at local level (the local development strategies of the communities in the two counties);

3.Preventing the phenomenon of early school leaving of the 2500 students in risk situations in the schools of the two counties;

4. Reintegration into education of 500 people who left / dropped out early school.

- 903 students receiving information, counseling and guidance in education and careers from Counseling and Support Centers for Parents and Children.
- over 2,000 parents / tutors of students at risk of early school leaving:
- 1,000 parents attending the Parents' School;
